The museum has limited personnel and funds to deal with the many engine enquiries we receive. Our archive holds in the region of 300,000 various engine records alone, and our volunteers are trying to collate all the data we have to make it more researchable, but this does take time. Lack of funds prevents us scanning the records onto electronic formats.

To help us help you, please provide at least the information marked in **BOLD**, without these we are unable to proceed with your enquiry. Please provide clear photographs to help us, unfortunately we cannot return these. We can only provide the dating service using postal mail; no electronic requests can be dealt with. The museum reserves the right to refuse any request for information at its discretion.

Currently, the museum can provide a dating record service for Crossley, Tangye, Mirrlees and Gardner engines; even then we cannot guarantee that we have all the records but will provide what information we can from those available. We also have a limited amount of information on National engines. **We currently do not provide a technical enquiry service.**
